

1. Employees of the British Council along with their relatives (up to second degree of kinship) are not eligible to apply for the British Council IELTS Award 2020.
2. Individuals wishing to apply for the British Council IELTS Award 2020 will need to ensure that they have their own access to the internet. The British Council is not responsible for assisting with access to websites or for providing other technical assistance to any applicant.
3. Applicants bear full responsibility for the complete and correct filling in and submission of their personal information.
4. By submitting an application for the British Council IELTS Award 2020 applicants hereby consent to the publication of their names on British Council websites.
5. Any information in your application (including anything you add at interview or afterwards) should be accurate, not omit any facts that are relevant and should not be misleading. If we find that there are significant errors or omissions in the information you have supplied to us in the course of your application, you will not be offered the award, or the award will be withdrawn or terminated.
6. The selection process will be fair. No applicant will have, or should seek or accept, any unfair advantage. If we find that you have secured an unfair advantage in the selection process, we reserve the right not to offer you an award or withdraw or terminate your award.
7. The decision of the awarding panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. The British Council IELTS Award 2020 is non-transferable and cannot be used by any person other than the successful applicant.
9. The British Council IELTS Award 2020, up to a maximum of £10,000 or the equivalent in euro or any other currency based on the exchange rate of the relevant currencies on the date of disbursement, will be paid directly to the institution of higher education in Greece or abroad, or to the college or other organisation of post-secondary education or vocational training where the successful applicant will undertake their course of study, subject to the British Council officially confirming their application status with the educational organisation.
10. The British Council reserves the right to withdraw the British Council IELTS Award 2020 at its discretion for a good reason after publishing this alteration appropriately and to the best of its knowledge.
11. The British Council will not bear any responsibility for the loss of the British Council IELTS Award should the organisation be unable to notify the successful applicant due to any issues connected to the email address provided, including, but not limited to, technical issues.
12. The British Council reserves the right to allocate or withdraw the British Council IELTS Award 2020 at its discretion should the successful applicant not respond to the British Council, including failure to provide the British Council with any required information and documentation by 6 July 2020 at the latest. In that case the British Council may grant the said award to the second successful applicant selected by the committee. In the event that after the payment of the tuition fees directly to the educational organisation of the first successful applicant's choice for the 2020 –21 academic year there is a remainder of the above award, then the British Council may also grant a part of the remainder to the second selected successful applicant, which will not exceed the sum granted to the former.

Commitment: If you receive the British Council IELTS Award 2020, you agree to become an IELTS ambassador to share your study experience with others in talks/seminars and feature in video clip(s) for the promotion of the British Council IELTS Award. You also agree to provide testimonials and photos, which may be published or used by the British Council for IELTS promotion purposes without receiving any remuneration or indemnity.
14. Entry clearance: If for any reason you cannot obtain a visa to study in the desired country of study (if a visa is required), then the British Council may withdraw the offer of the award.
15. The British Council is committed to equality of opportunity and ensures that there is no unjustified discrimination on the basis of gender including transgender, marital status, sexual orientation, religion and belief, age, disability, political opinion, ethnicity/race or socio-economic background, and values the diversity of individuals. The sole consideration in the selection of the successful applicant will be applicants' ability to meet the eligibility and suitability criteria of the award.
