#### **Choosing your course**

- Choose your course FIRST
- Over 50,000 to choose from
- Familiar or new subject?
- Career plans?
- Will it interest you for 3 or 4 years?
- YOUR decision



#### **Types of courses**

- BA, BSc, BEng, LLB, BEng or integrated Masters
  - (Are you going to study an Arts, Science, Law, Engineering or Integrated MA degree?)
  - Single vs Joint honours (X and Y, X with Y)
  - Theory or practical

(This will affect how much time you will spend in seminars/lectures/in a lab vs self-study)

- Courses are typically 3 years in England but can be up to 5 years:
- Foundation year
- Study abroad
- Placement year


**Studying Abroad** At university

#### **Placement Years**




- Optional for most degrees
