Warwick Undergraduate Global Excellence Scholarship 2025

- Full-fee scholarships (100% off tuition!)
- Half-fee scholarships (50% off tuition!)
- Quarter- fee scholarships (25% Off tuition!)
- **Valid for the full duration of your studies**

Criteria 2025

- Be self-funded
- Be classed as an 'overseas' or 'international-fee paying' student for tuition fee purposes
- Submit your UCAS application before the UCAS deadline
- Available for any subject area
- You don't need to have an offer to apply

What would you say to someone considering applying for an Undergraduate Global Excellence Scholarship at Warwick?

I would advise someone, that they should do the application process on their own, because that's how they will find out if they are really passionate of studying abroad the course they chose. Also who knows you better than you do ? Furthermore, be careful to read the instructions, make sure you are eligible, and last but definitely not least, do not leave it till the last minute.

 - have an undergraduate degree, be motivated and have an interest in the proposed subject area
 - meet the English language requirement of the UK university
 - establish an engagement with the UK as a scholar, through personal and academic fulfilment
 - be willing to attend a networking event of all UK based GREAT scholars, to discuss experiences and capture perceptions of studying in the UK
 - be willing to maintain contact with the British Council and their HEI and act as an ambassador for the GREAT Scholarships
 - as an alumnus of the GREAT Scholarships, be willing occasionally to speak to potential candidates about his or her own experience of studying in the UK
