Employability Skills

- Transferable skills built into programmes:
 - decision making; team working; time management; communication, leadership; problem solving; critical thinking....
- Accreditations – Kent Business School, School of Biosciences, School of Psychology
- Work experience as part of the programme e.g. Kent Law Clinic, Year in Industry opportunities
- Placement options, HSBC, GSK, Microsoft
- Careers Advisory Service – workshops, career fairs, employability awards
- Working during study – part time roles or internships
- Work after study – UK's Graduate Route



British Council GREAT Scholarship

- Funded jointly by the UK Government's GREAT Britain campaign, British Council and the University of Kent
- £10,000 towards the tuition fees for one year of study
- Students must submit an essay via their portal, 500 words about: “a topic you have studied previously and why you found it interesting. This topic should be related to or have inspired you to apply for your chosen degree programme.”
- Application deadline: **Friday 26 April 2024, 17:00 BST**
- Applicants must be a citizen of China, Ghana, Greece, India, Kenya, Thailand or Turkey and an overseas fee payer. These countries change each year
- Applicants must be active in the field with work experience or proven interest in the subject area, and be willing to act as an ambassador for UK Higher Education
- Students must have received a conditional or unconditional offer for a one year programme at a UK campus to be able to submit their scholarship application. Students who have applied for a Year in Industry aren't eligible.
- Students must have accepted their offer from Kent by the deadline for their application to be considered
